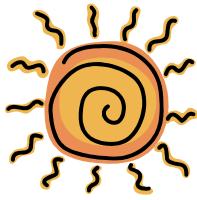

Strategic Transportation Safety Plan - The MPO is currently gathering information and preparing the scope of work for the Safety Plan. We anticipate the RFP for the Safety Plan to be ready to advertise by September/October 2014.

Transit Implementation Plan - The MPO is currently gathering information and preparing the scope of work for the Transit Implementation Plan. We anticipate the RFP for the Transit Implementation Plan to be ready to advertise by September/October 2014.

The 2014 Grant Award for the 5311 was announced. The City of Coolidge received \$1,250,290.

At the June 26th TAC meeting, it was requested that a general overview of all transit funding opportunities available to the MPO members be provided. Below is an overview of each funding:

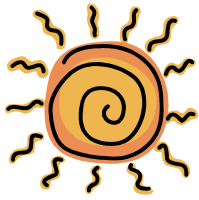
- **5303 Metropolitan Transportation Planning Program**
 - Available for planning and research activities.
 - Available to Sun Corridor MPO
 - Available to Metropolitan Planning Organization's
- **5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program**
 - Available to fund bus purchases, transit capital projects, preventative maintenance, and ADA/Para-transit operations.
 - Available to small urban areas (50,000 to 200,000 in population)
- **5310 Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities Program**
 - The purpose of assisting private nonprofit groups in meeting the transportation needs of the elderly and persons with disabilities. Program funds are used for capital assistance, the purchase of vehicles, related equipment and operating funds.
 - Available to private nonprofit and public agencies that provide transportation to the elderly and disabled. Examples include senior centers and programs for the physically, mentally (including seriously mental ill or SMI) and developmentally disabled (DD)

- Competitive application process
- **5311 Rural Public Transportation Program: Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP) & Intercity Bus Program**
 - This program provides funds for public transportation and intercity bus projects serving rural areas
 - Available to counties, cities, towns and American Indian tribes.

SUBJECT: HSIP Projects – Programming Scenarios

The Sun Corridor MPO staff received seven HSIP applications. Irene has reviewed all applications for eligibility and has provided comments back to member agencies. The deadline to submit the final FY15 applications to ADOT LPA Section for eligibility approval is **September 15, 2014**.

TIP Amendment #3 places the potential HSIP projects in the HSIP “Parking Lot” until eligibility approval is granted from ADOT/FHWA. The HSIP Projects will be moved to the appropriate programmed year when eligibility approval is granted from ADOT/FHWA. The deadline to receive HSIP eligibility approval from ADOT/FHWA is October 31, 2014. All “Project Initiation Request” for eligible projects must be initiated by the member agency no later than November 15, 2014.

Potential HSIP Projects:

- City of Casa Grande - Upgrade Pedestrian Countdown Heads II and APS, Total \$89,848
- City of Coolidge - SR87 at Ruins Dr., MP 134.28 in COOLIDGE, Safeway Traffic Signal, Total \$742,001
- City of Eloy - Upgrade Regulatory Signs, Total \$189,048
- City of Eloy - Upgrade Pavement Markings, Total \$362,278
- Pinal County - Sign Management System and Sign Upgrade, Total \$271,399

Sun Corridor staff created three HSIP programming scenarios on pages 14-16 of this packet. The following should be taken into consideration when programming:

- Development/design and construction can no longer be programmed in the same FFY. This includes the procurement of equipment.
- Sun Corridor MPO receives approximately \$493,130 each FFY for safety projects.
- Sun Corridor has a loan repayment scheduled for FFY16 in the amount of \$120,693 therefore, reducing the amount of funding available to \$372,437.
