6 Air Quality Update

Jason Hafner provided the following update:

The Spring 2017 Conformity Analysis is complete. MAG is currently establishing the Target Years for the Spring 2018 Air Quality Conformity process. Once those are established we will begin collecting data

ADEQ, MAG and Pinal County Air Quality developed a draft emission inventory for the Hidden Valley area covering PM10 emissions. The purpose was to better understand what is causing exceedances there. We have recoded 25 exceedances of the PM10 NAAQS so far in 2017.

Pinal County will be sending out a reminder in November to each public works departments requesting the annual unpaved road report. The reports are due by the end on January 2018.

7 Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) Planner Update

Jason Bottjen provided the following update:

Long Range Transportation Plan - The Tentative 2040 Long-Range Transportation Plan was presented to the State Transportation Board study session on October 20th. The plan is out for public comment period through December 21st.

During the 25-year period of this draft plan, about \$923 million in annual highway capital funding will be available from state and federal sources. On average, the Phoenix and Tucson regions are expected to receive \$512 million annually. Of that, \$223 million comes from voter-approved regional programs in those two metropolitan areas dedicated largely to highway expansion. ADOT's Recommended Investment Choice calls for all of the remaining annual average of \$411 million to go toward preserving and modernizing highways in Greater Arizona.

Arizona Freight Plan - The Freight plan is complete and pending FHWA approval.

8 Federal Highways Administration (FHWA) Update

Irene Higgs provided the following update:

The MPO is currently working with ADOT, FHWA and other MPO's to establish targets for the following:

- CMAQ Congestion Mitigation and AQ Program
- Travel Time Reliability
- Freight Reliability

Once ADOT establishes targets in 2018 - the MPO will have 180 days to either adopt State targets or establish their own.

9 District Engineer Update

Rod Lane provided an update on all ADOT projects within in the region.

 - Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Update (10.1) Irene Higgs provided an overview of activities that were attended during the months of September, October and a portion of November.
 - Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2017 Ledger (10.2) The MPO just received the October 2017 ledger from ADOT and has not had time to do a complete review. At first glance there is some funding missing from the ledger. Staff will work with ADOT to correct.
 - Design/Construction Report (10.3) Jason Hafner provided the following update on projects:
 - Kortsen TI DCR (Page 28 Item 1) Duane and I are working on the project initiation paperwork for this currently.
 - SR 87 and Ruins Drive Traffic Signal (p.30) Project is scheduled to advertise in December 2017. Current estimate is \$579,547 we have it programmed for \$525k, so I am working on an Administrative Amendment to the TIP.
 - Non-Federal Funding Ledger (10.4) Irene Higgs provided an overview of the Non-federal Funding Ledger. She stated that the current balance is \$97,717.29. The MPO utilized some of the non-federal funding to purchased gift basket items for the Rural Summit.
 - 2017 Annual Title VI Report to ADOT Results (10.5) Irene Higgs provided an overview of the results from the 2017 MPO Goals and Accomplishment Report.
 - Sun Corridor Exporting Program 2018 (EDGE) (10.6) The MPO is partnering with MAG and PAG to rollout the 2018 EDGE (Economic Development for Global Economy) program. EDGE recognizes business in three categories emerging, proficient or expert. Top scoring business will be highlighted for each county Maricopa, Pinal and Pima. All participating business will be featured in a video, press release and event (JPAC).
 - **HURF Exchange Program** The HURF Exchange Program is expected to kick-off in January 2018. Two year window for completion is once design is completed. ADOT is still trying to determine when the clock would start ticking for the two year window.

Mayor McFarland would like to know the status of ADOT hiring the GRIC Liaison for the widening of I-10 from Casa Grande to Chandler.
