Transportation Advisory Committee Meeting: February 28, 2019

Pinal Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) Update - Agenda Item #8

- November 7, 2017 – Pinal County voters approved Propositions 416 (Pinal Regional Transportation Plan) and 417 (County Transportation Excise Tax).
- April 1, 2018 – Tax went into effect.
- November 15, 2018 – Judge ruled that Proposition 417 was void and unenforceable as the tax only extended to retail sales and not all privilege tax categories as required by state statute.
- February 19, 2019 – CAG was awarded FTA Section 5305(e) planning funds to conduct a countywide transit governance study on behalf of the RTA.
- February 26, 2019 – Pinal County’s legal counsel filed the Appellate Court motion.
Total revenue in the escrow account is \$10.6 million.
RTA General Manager is working with legal counsel to draft reimbursement agreements for costs associated with RTA approved projects.

Pinal County Strategic Transportation Safety Plan Update Local Government Project Report - Agenda Item #10

- November 30, 2017 – Notice to proceed issued to AMEC Foster Wheeler (Wood) November 30, 2017 with Greenlight Traffic Engineering as the subconsultant.
- January 9, 2019 – Safety Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) meeting was held with 21 people attending. The STAC discussed potential HSIP project applications.
- February 6, 2019 – The project team met with city of Apache Junction staff to discuss potential HSIP project applications.
- February 20, 2019 – The project team met with the Board of Supervisors and Pinal County staff to discuss potential HSIP project applications.
- May 2019 – Draft Plan, Possible STAC meeting, and Public Outreach in Apache Junction, Maricopa, and San Tan Valley
- May-June 2019 – Agency Board-Council-Committee presentations and Final Plan

Pinal County Local Government Project Report - Agenda Item #17

- **Pinal County Sign Upgrade Project, ADOT TRACS SH645 03D/01C**
 - March 2017 – The sign project was awarded to Main Street Signs with a contract start date in March 2017.
 - May 2017 – The kick-off meeting was conducted.
 - December 2017 – ADOT inspected the signs and Pinal County was authorized to install.
 - January 23, 2019 – Pinal County sign crew has completed the installation of 1,638 signs.

Tentative 2020- 2024 5-Year Construction Program

The **Tentative 2020-2024 Five Year Facilities Construction Program** was approved by the State Transportation Board on February 15th at the State Transportation Board meeting in Douglas. The Tentative 5 Year Construction Program will be available via the ADOT website on March 13th, followed by a Public Hearing in conjunction with the State Transportation Board Meeting March 15th in Tucson.

There are two additional public hearings on April 12th in Flagstaff and May 17th in Phoenix.

Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

Below are the key dates for HSIP eligibility:

1. **HSIP Applications due no later than May 3, 2019***
2. ADOT HSIP Applications submitted for review no later than April 1, 2019
3. HSIP Safety Committee Meeting in July 2019 (TBD)
4. Eligibility determination due no later than October 4, 2019

Anticipated HSIP Available Funds by SFY*: As of January 7, 2018

SFY23: \$35,000,000.00

SFY24: \$35,000,000.00

Changes to the HSIP Program:

- All applications are submitted for SFY23 thru SFY24 programs.
- Select information technology system equipment can be purchased for new AZTraCS implementation. The \$250,000.00 minimum project cost is lowered to \$5,000.00 for these projects. (Currently, this funding is on-hold until final ADOT management approval.)
- HSIP funds can be used for yearly licensing fees for statewide crash data software with ADOT approval
- The comprehensive unit costs for fatal and serious injury crashes have increased in the B/C ratio calculation sheet (Due to statewide actuarial adjustment)
- The minimum B/C ratio increases to ≥ 2.5 (Due to increased actuarial adjustments)
- An inflation factor of 5% has been added to Cost Estimate Tabs to account for estimated inflation between project selection and 2023 (This is only an estimate and ADOT takes no responsibility for ultimate accuracy. Individual agencies may select higher inflationary estimates.)
- Total project costs for non-infrastructure projects, i.e. SHSPs, RSAs, licensing fees, etc. are capped at 5% of the yearly SFY HSIP available funds.
