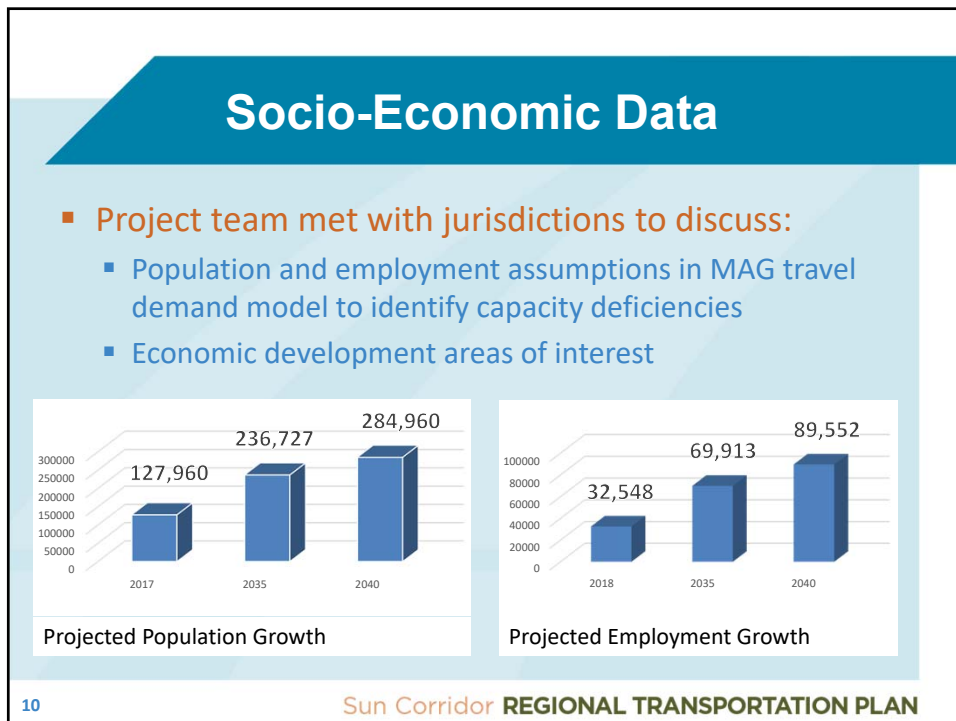
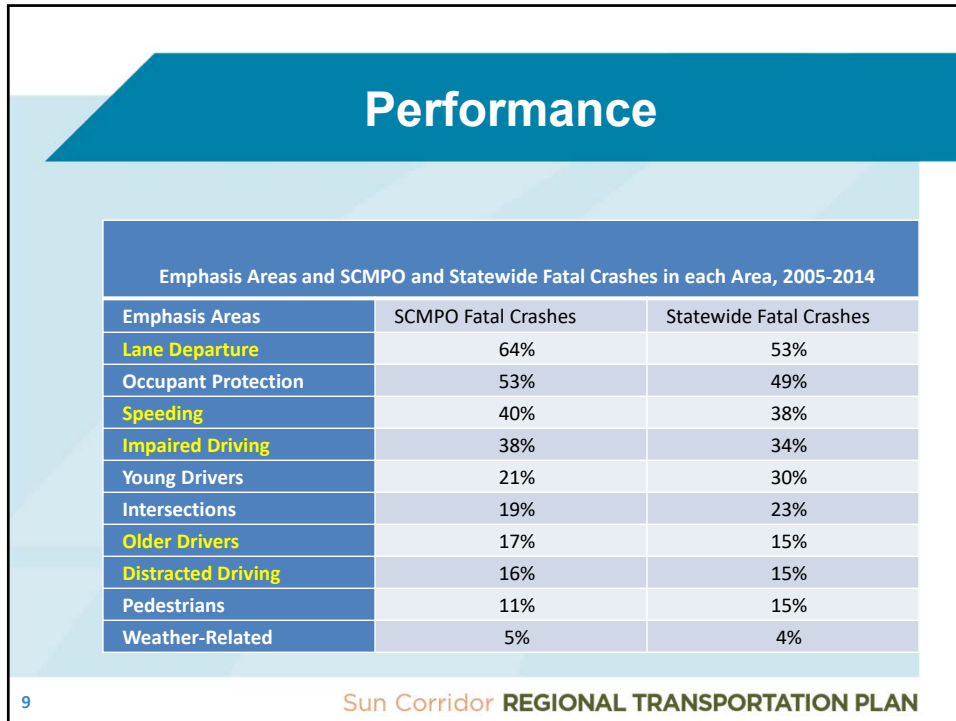
- **2016 RTP**

 - 2020 RTP will report on progress on both sets of performance measures

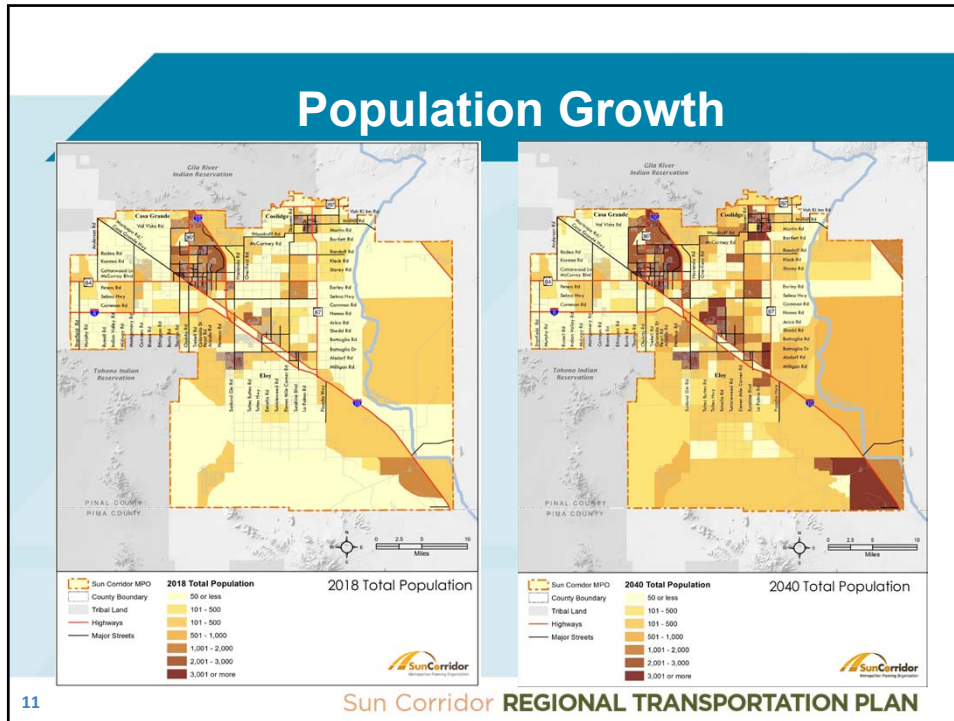

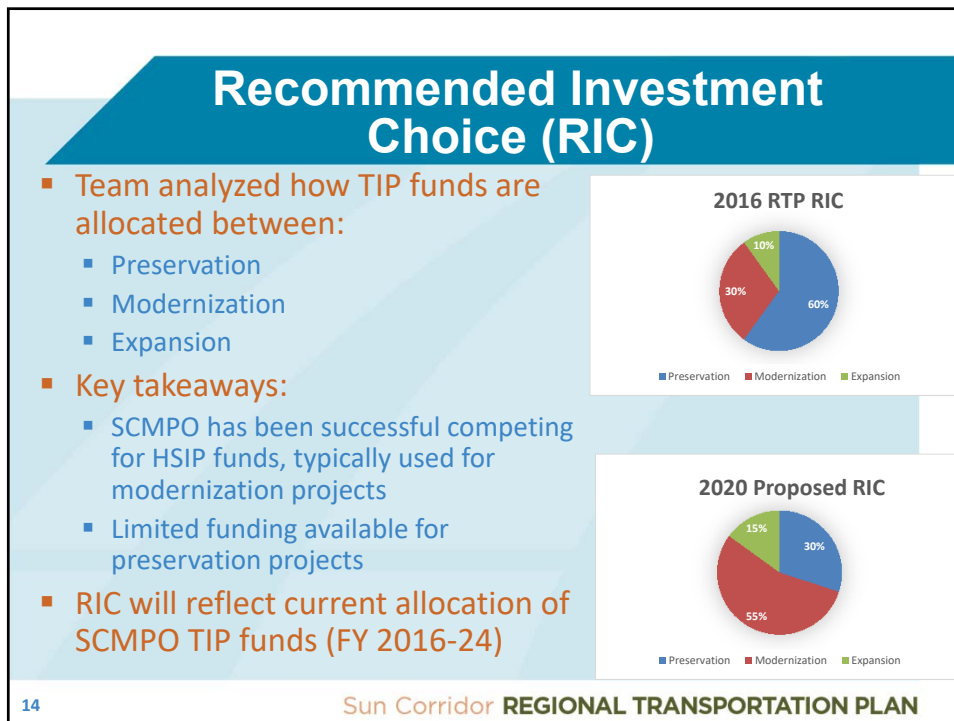
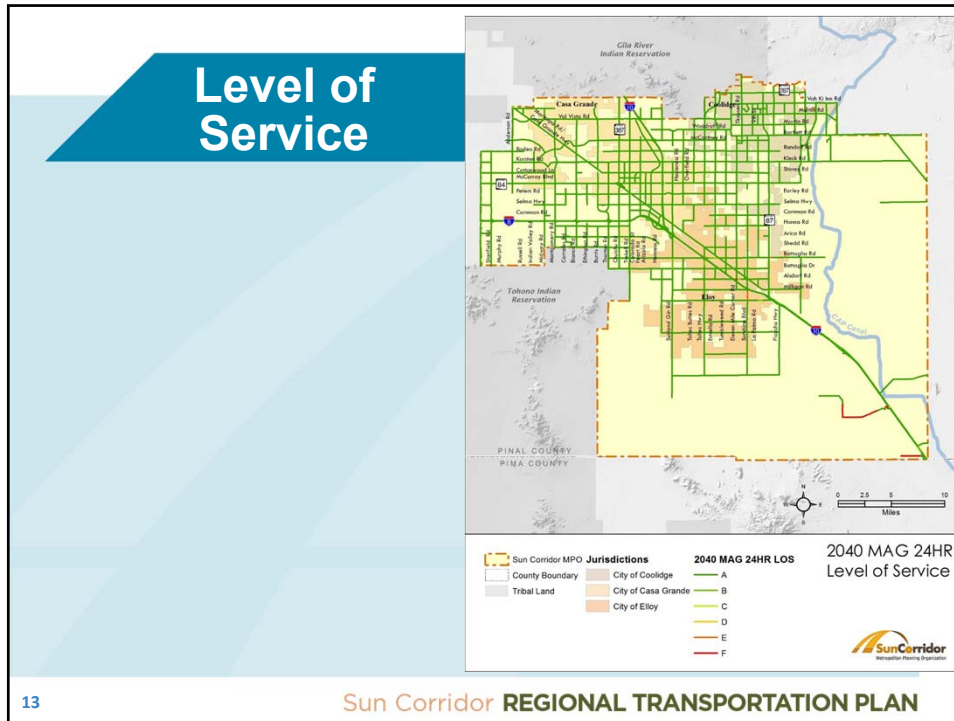
